COVID-19 Safety Measures

As you know, with the assistance of the Hyatt organization, we moved our conference from April to June to allow time for wider distribution of the COVID vaccine. We are thankful that the vaccine is now widely available to everyone. Our first priority is the safety and transformational onsite experience of our attendees.

Here are key safety points (as of 6.1.21) from the Hyatt Regency Grand Cypress.

MASK POLICY: Masks are no longer required to be worn by Hotel guests anywhere on the Hotel property. As of this update, staff will still be required to wear masks, but this could change in the next couple of weeks. We encourage our attendees to do whatever makes you more comfortable.

COMMITMENT TO CLEAN: Hyatt has increased the cleaning and disinfecting of high-touch surfaces, such as elevator buttons, door handles, public restrooms, escalators and stairs handrails, including wiping down all surfaces. Rooms will also be sanitized after each breakout session. Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrance of every meeting room. Proper PPE is required for all Hyatt colleagues.

SOCIAL DISTANCING: Hyatt guests and associates are asked to practice **social distancing using the updated standard of three-feet**. The Hotel has placed signs in areas for reminders. Social distancing will also apply to all classrooms, elevators, restaurants, and guidelines will vary by classroom set-up, but we will be doing minimum resets each day.

FOOD: The Hyatt's restaurants have implemented policies to allow for limited touch and proper social distancing. And all hard touch surfaces are cleaned and disinfected frequently. All restaurants use single-use disposable menus. For conference meals provided by The Alliance, we will offer either self-service box lunches, or pre-plated meals for special paid events like the Men's Breakfast and Women's luncheon.

CHECK-IN: Contactless check-in is available at the front desk using Mobile Key – download the World of Hyatt App prior to check-in to use this feature. There will be a queuing system to manage lines. Please note, there will be Self-Parking and **now valet is available**. Bellmen are available to assist with luggage and they will ensure carts are sanitized after each use.
