THE HEART OF A LEADER

The most persistent barrier to leading like Jesus is a heart motivated by self-interest. Self-serving leaders operate out of pride and fear with an attitude of "give little, take a lot." Since this condition is more often a blind spot than a conscious choice, we want to help you take a deep, honest look at your heart first. You see, a good diagnosis must precede effective treatment. If we don't get the heart right, nothing else can turn out right either.

During this session you will:

- 1. Answer the question many are asking: Why the heart?
- 2. Understand a clear distinction between healthy and an unhealthy heart.
- 3. Learn three critical ways leaders diminish their influence.
- 4. Discover three simple ways to restore your influence and leadership.
